## *Moment, in the Stillness*

[New York, NY] – Gambit Gallery is pleased to present *Moment, in the Stillness*, a solo exhibition by Korean artist ByeongDoo Moon. The exhibition features a group of monumental sculptures constructed from stainless steel wire, shaped through processes of bending and welding into complex, open structures.

Moon's practice is rooted in the transformation of industrial wire into organic form. Using thousands of interconnected lines, he builds volumetric structures that suggest animals, bodies, and hybrid beings. These works do not enclose mass but define it through accumulation and tension, allowing space to remain visible within the form. His sculptures engage themes of coexistence between humans and nature, translating this relationship into a physical language of interconnection and balance.

Scale plays a central role. At a monumental level, the density and extension of the wire structures create an expanded spatial presence, while maintaining a sense of lightness and permeability. The works appear both solid and open, stable yet continuously shifting as one moves around them.

Rather than presenting fixed narratives, Moon constructs forms that remain structurally precise but visually fluid. His sculptures emphasize the tension between industrial material and organic imagery, using steel wire to articulate a space where natural and human-made systems intersect.

*Moment, in the Stillness* is on view April 2nd through May 14th.
